\$50 Million!

The Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile Foundation is very proud of our donation to Shriners Hospitals for Children® for the year ending 2011. The annual contribution for the fiscal year just ended brings the total contributions from Daughters of the Nile to over \$50 million.

A Foundation check in the amount of \$1,462,317.66 was delivered to Imperial Treasurer, Gene Bracewell. This check together with an additional \$15,000.00 given to the Philadelphia Hospital from the Louis F. Meyers Trust, brings the annual total from the United States Daughters of the Nile members to \$1,477,317.66.

The Daughters of the Nile Canadian Founda-



tion check for \$203,887.000 which was sent to the Canadian Hospital from Canadian members brings the total cash donation to the Shriners Hospitals for Children® for this year to \$1,681,204.66.

All members of the Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile are extremely proud that our total cash giving now totals over \$50 million, although this amount does not include the value associated

with additional monies, services and goods given directly to the hospitals by our Subordinate Temples.

In February, a third Million Dollar Plaque was placed on the philanthropic wall of Shriners Hospitals for Children® -Tampa, and a third Million Dollar Plaque will be placed in Philadelphia in July.

Meet Madalyn: An Energetic Young Girl!!

Madalynn Penaflor was born in May 2006, and joined her brothers Dawson and Dylan who were six and three at the time. A few minutes after her birth, a nurse noticed she had only four toes on her right foot and when trying to stretch her out to measure her length, the nurse noticed that the child's right leg was considerably shorter than her left. The family was told that, based on the x-rays, she had a malformed hip and she was missing her fibula and her toe. They took her home to wait for an appointment with a pediatric orthopedic surgeon at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago.

After the visit to Children's, the family was told Madi had Proximal Femoral Focal Deficiency and Congenital Longitudinal Fibular Deficiency. They also learned her anomaly was more severe than they first thought. She didn't simply have a malformed hip, she appeared to have no hip joint and just a few inches of femur above the knee. The recommendation was to amputate her foot and go with a full leg prosthesis belted around her waist. A second

opinion was recommended. Meg dissolved into tears when they suggested amputation of

the foot. "How would she tell her brothers and how could she do this to her baby girl?"

The family sought a second opinion. They were also told her foot was straight and her ankle was structurally sound and that it would be a good base for a prosthetic, so it did not need to be amputated.



Robert, Madi's father, knew the financial impact of a child with a disability can be devastating, but the family was driven by faith and a strong desire to one day see their daughter walk.

A local man the family knew through friends happened to hear Madi's story from his secretary and offered to call Shriners Hospitals for Children® for help. The family received an application, filled it in, and expected to wait the usual four to six weeks to hear

if Madi was accepted. Two weeks later, a phone call from the Shriners Hospital for Children® - Chicago was received advising them of Madi's acceptance. In addition to free medical care for Madi, the family was provided a home away from home through the Ronald McDonald House, something the Penaflors never expected.

In August 2006, Madi visited Shriners Hospitals for Children® for the first time. They confirmed her diagnosis and told the family of the options for her care. The family was overjoyed knowing they would not have to make a decision to amputate in order for her to get around and participate in whatever she wanted to. At eight weeks, Madi began physical therapy and was fitted with a full-leg prosthesis when she was nine months.

As she grew, her prosthetic leg was adjusted, or she was fitted for a new one. Each time, the Shriners offered medical, emotional and financial assistance.

Madi never ceased to amaze her doctors or her parents. "She would run out of the room after an adjustment of the old prosthetic." Meg said, "Madi has two speeds,

Happy Birthday, Daughters of the Nile!





dead stop and full speed – all because of Shriners!”

In May 2010, just before her fourth birthday, Madi had a rotationplasty procedure so she could have a prosthesis with a knee joint built into it. She controls the devise with her foot and ankle, as her right ankle is parallel to her left knee. This allows her to continue to dance, run, and be more like a typical child her age. The surgery took six hours and she was in a body cast for six weeks.

In August, doctors discovered the rod that was inserted during surgery to hold her still healing tibia in place separated and her leg rotated back around. Madi had to undergo another surgery to reset the bone, rod and rotation of the leg. She was in a body cast again, the second time in less than two months. Dur-



ing the healing, doctors added a foot and pion to the cast so she could begin bearing weight on her leg as the bone healed. She was told she could bear weight on it if she used a walker. Within fifteen minutes after this discussion, as the Shrine driver and her father were getting the walker out for her to use, she took her mothers' hand and started walking!

Fearless, Madi also took up therapeutic horseback riding. She joined an organization that helps special needs children and adults with horseback riding and related services. The staff and volunteers showed Madi that she could ride a horse---even in a body cast. Her mom watched her daughter light up. “It was like the electricity got turned back on,” she said. Madi conquered her fear in no time. On her first ride, mom joined her, but only for a few steps. Madi asked her to get off the horse. Later she asked, “Is this all the faster we’re gonna go?” This type of therapy can help to improve social and cognitive skills. Meg said the center allows her daughter and others with disabilities, “to be who they are.”

The staff and volunteers showed Madi that she could ride a horse.
