## \$1.7 Million to SHC

Shriners Hospitals for Children® received over \$1.7 million from the Daughters of the Nile Foundation, the Canadian Foundation and the Louis Fredrick Meyer trust in early 2013, representing contributions and earnings for the 2012 fiscal year.

This amount sets a record high distribution of funds

from the Daughters of the Nile.


be considered a success.”

## My Scoliosis Journey

*'People generally have about a 10 degree curved spine. My curve was 65 degrees and was a perfect shaped "S" curve.'*

We never know what life has in store for us. I never understood the expression, "everything happens for a reason." I now believe that things happen to make us better people. An allergy sufferer since the age of two, a coughing spell on

Thanksgiving, 2010, began my journey. I rarely complained about my back, but once in a while I can remember thinking "my back is kind of sore." No big deal, we all get sore backs from doing too much. After my coughing spell, I had a considerable amount of pain in my back. The next morning, I had a large hump under my left shoulder blade. My mom took me to a chiropractor, thinking that perhaps I threw out my back or twisted something. That was indeed the case, being diagnosed by Dr. Ziamba. However, through x-rays, Dr. Z. noticed something else. It was easy to throw out my

back because I had scoliosis. The medical term officially being, "Adolescent Idiopathic Scoliosis," simply meaning, no known reason for the curvature of the spine. After several treatments from Dr. Z., my back was

referred to a teaching hospital.

My parents researched Shriners Hospitals for Children®-Tampa. After applying, they accepted my case and scheduled an appointment for January

2011. It was at that appointment that I met some of the most wonderful people that I will ever meet. Dr. Geoffrey Cronen is the director of spinal surgery. He divides his time between his own orthopaedic practice and his

volunteer work at the hospital. It was about 10 minutes into my appointment when he said, "There are no options. Miranda needs surgery." It was a long 3 hours riding home from Tampa, with us processing what would happen over the next few months.

My pre-op day at the hospital was a busy one. I met with my medical team of about



back in alignment, the hump was a little smaller, and I needed to see an orthopaedic specialist. People generally have about a 10 degree curved spine. My curve was 65 degrees and was a perfect "S" shaped curve. Generally curves over 40 degrees are treated with spinal fusion. Under 40 can be treated by wearing a brace. My diagnosis was confirmed after receiving a second opinion from an orthopaedic surgeon. I was

10 people. They each explained their role in my surgery and recovery while at the hospital and how I would recover at home.

On April 25, 2011 at 6:00 a.m., I entered the hospital to prepare for surgery. I was in the operating room for seven hours. My surgeon listed to country music during the procedure (he's from Kentucky.) I don't remember a lot about my 5 days in the hospital. I was on a lot of medication. We talk about it sometimes and my mom fills in the days where I have very little memory. I was expected to walk a lot right after surgery and my family had to learn how to lift, turn, and make me comfortable, which was hard to



do. The end result of the surgery—2 rods and 24 screws straightened the curve of my spine.

*Editor's note:* Miranda has organized a Scoliosis Awareness Charity Walk, to bring awareness to the



community and educate others about this condition. She has started a support group through the Scoliosis Association and has organized her own non-profit called *Standing Straight 4 Scoliosis, Inc.* She says, "For the most part, this project made me realize that the community is supportive and as many times as I have given to community events, it was an honor to have it given to me. In February 2013, Shriners Hospitals for Children® received \$3,200 from the proceeds of Miranda's efforts! She plans to continue this event, using what she has learned to make each one better and more profitable."
