

Over the years many of you ladies have asked us how much of our spending supports Shriners Children’s™. A non-profit organization’s success is measured by how much is spent on Program Services versus how much is spent on Overhead. The Foundation is extremely proud that our three-year average through 2020 is .90 cents of every dollar spent by the Foundation is for Program Services. .05 cents of every dollar spent is for Overhead and the remaining .05 cents of every dollar is for Fundraising. Per Charity Navigator, the Shriners Children’s™ three-year average through 2019 is .81 cents of every dollar spent is for Program Services, .12 cents for Overhead and .07 cents for Fundraising. Charity Navigator rates non-profits on fiscal responsibility based on these three categories. Charity Navigator rates a non-profit as having zero fiscal responsibility if their Overhead is over 30% (.30 cents on every dollar). Daughters of the Nile Foundation has a 100% rating from Charity Navigator. Average non-profit Overhead spending is between 15% and 25%. This is really stellar performance!

We look forward to an exciting and successfully 2022!

## **SUPPORT THE DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE FOUNDATION 501(c)(3)**

### **QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD)**

**(AGES 70.5+)**

- **Donate up to \$100,000 of your Roth or traditional IRA each year directly to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation.**
- **Under this provision, direct distributions are excluded from income and are equivalent to a 100% deduction.**
- **Build a future of continued giving and receive a charitable receipt.**

### **REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION (RMD)**

**(AGES 72+)**

- **You must withdraw from your IRA, regardless of whether you need the income - and this is subject to income tax.**
- **You may satisfy your required IRA distribution without reporting additional income by donating it directly to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation.**
- **Invest in our mission of supporting the Shriners Hospitals for Children® and receive a charitable receipt.**

Donating IRA assets can be a financially rewarding strategy for both you and the Daughters of the Nile Foundation. As always, please consult your financial representative or tax advisor before making any decisions that alter your tax situation.

## **How to Maximize Your Charitable Giving to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation**

Matching gifts are a type of giving program that is setup by companies and corporations as an employee benefit. After an employee donates to a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, they can submit a matching gift request to their employer and the company will make an additional donation to that nonprofit. Companies usually match donations at a 1:1 ratio, but some will match a 2:1, 3:1 or even a 4:1 ratio.

Corporate matching gifts are valuable because they are free money for the Daughters of the Nile Foundation! Using corporate matching gifts multiplies your gift and the Daughters of the Nile Foundation will receive two donations. It is a win-win for both the donor and the company.

Corporate matching gifts are an efficient and straightforward way for companies to build relationships with charities.

How to get started?

1. Employee makes a gift to a 501(c)(3).
2. Check with your employer if you are eligible for matching gifts.
3. If you are eligible, ask for the necessary forms. Fill out the forms and the Daughters of the Nile Foundation benefits.

Giving money or real estate to a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit is considered charitable giving.

There are special events, fundraisers, and of course that holiday season push. But what about the rest of the year? We want to encourage you to consider doubling your donation year-round by using the corporate matching gift program.
